# 1 Overview

ISO 2022 is an international standard for financial messaging, providing a common language and format for exchanging financial information between institutions. It uses the eXtensible Markup Language (XML) to provide a common language and structure across the financial industry to enhance interoperability and support a wide range of financial transactions globally.

The Cross-border Payments and Reporting Plus(CBPR+) guidelines defines how ISO 2022 should be used for cross-border payments, High Value Domestic Payments and cash reporting on the SWIFT network. Standard Chartered (the Bank) has adopted the CBPR+ guidelines as part of ISO 2022 implementation for the interpretation of financial transaction messages to support our financial institution and corporate clients to have more harmonized implementations across different systems and regions.

To align with the CBPR+ guidelines, our Payment, Beneficiary (Earlier Label: Payee) and On-Behalf-Of Payer (OBO) modules on Straight2Bank Web have been updated along with the enhanced user experience to make it easier for you to submit the transactions and parties information.

Please go through this user guide to familiarize yourself with the ISO 2022 changes on different web journeys (Payment, Beneficiary, OBO). This document will guide you in navigating the module with step-by-step instructions and screenshots, as well as to answer any questions you may have.

# 2 Getting Started

ISO 20022 is an open global payment messaging standard that provides significantly richer, better structured data during payment processing, and potentially after transaction processing for reconciliation, reporting and analytics purposes. The enhanced message structure includes dedicated structured elements to capture details like:

- Structured Postal Addresses & LEI for identification of Parties/Agents (Banks)
- Presence of Purpose Codes/Regulatory Purpose codes to capture intent of payment.
- Unique Identifiers (UETR, Payment Reference Number, End To End ID, Batch Reference Number etc.) for better tracking
- Extended Character set which includes non-Latin characters

We have redesigned the Payment, On-Behalf-Of Payer (OBO) and Beneficiary (Earlier Label: Payee) modules on Straight2Bank Web to support minimum mandatory fields required as per Cross-border Payments and Reporting Plus (CBPR+) guidelines. Broad outline of the changes is given below and step by step detailed information is given in the subsequent chapters of this user guide.

**Note: As part of ISO change ‘Payee’ will be renamed to ‘Beneficiary’. Wherever Beneficiary reference is given in user guide, please relate it to existing Payee reference.**

- Beneficiary (Earlier Label: Payee) and On-Behalf-Of Payers (OBO) modules are enhanced on Straight2Bank Web to support structured fields (Address, Identification) along with updates to few existing fields to support the maximum length and character set as per CBPR+ guidelines.
- New Party (Ultimate Beneficiary, Final Party which receives the payment amount in the end) is introduced in the Straight2Bank Web payment screen along with updates to few existing payment fields to support the maximum length and character set as per CBPR+ guidelines. For this payment type, please mention final creditor to whom money is credited to.
- Existing bulk import specification for Payment (ipayment.csv) and Beneficiary (Bulk Import-Beneficiary.csv) is updated to support newly introduced ISO fields along with updates to few existing fields to support the maximum length and character set as per CBPR+ guidelines.
- Introduction of new file utility to support bulk import of On-Behalf-Of Payers (Bulk Import-OBO.csv) for smooth address migration of pre-defined OBOs from unstructured to Structured or Hybrid Address in bulk.
- Existing Print PDF layout is updated for Payment module to reflect newly introduced ISO fields along with changes to the existing field lengths.
- Beneficiary and On-Behalf-Of Payer (OBO) modules are enhanced using new UX framework for faster screen loading along with enhanced built-in error checking in the forms for seamless user experience.

In nutshell, the major changes on Straight2Bank Web for ISO20022 can be divided into three major blocks.



**Inclusion of new structured fields (Address, Identification) as per CBPR+ guidelines.**



**Update to few existing fields to support the maximum length and character set as per CBPR+ guidelines.**



**Enhancement of Beneficiary and OBO modules using new UX framework.**

# 3 New Structured Fields



## Overview

For Postal addresses which are essential for the proper identification of parties in financial transactions, ISO 20022 assigns dedicated fields to each data element like street name, building number, postal code, town name, and country code to facilitate detailed data capture, to enhance the efficiency of payment processing, and to improve sanction screening. Similarly, there are dedicated fields to capture party identification details.

**Standard Chartered has introduced structured/hybrid address and party identification fields in Straight2Bank Web in Beneficiary, On-Behalf-Of Payer (OBO) and Ultimate Beneficiary screen as per CBPR+ guidelines. You are required to enter structured or hybrid address for parties starting from timeline as instructed by Standard Chartered communication.**

**Please reach out to your dedicated relationship manager to access CBPR+ web address guideline for more details on difference between various address type like Structured and Hybrid Address and refer to Standard Chartered's client communication for instruction regarding address type to use for different parties.**



## Important Notes for Structured/Hybrid Address

- As per industry timeline of November 2026, Structured/Hybrid Address will become mandatory for **Beneficiary (ISO Term: Creditor)**. **Standard Chartered will make structured/hybrid address mandatory for new beneficiary creation starting from May 2026. Bank highly recommends you use structured or hybrid Address for Beneficiaries and also to start migrating address of your pre-defined Beneficiary from unstructured to structured or hybrid to avoid any inconvenience.** Industry will stop supporting unstructured address post November 2026 for Beneficiary.
- Structured/Hybrid Address is mandatory for **On-Behalf-Of Payer (ISO Term: Ultimate Debtor) and Ultimate Beneficiary (ISO Term: Ultimate Creditor)** starting November 2025. **Standard Chartered encourages you to provide structured/hybrid address for your one-time and pre-defined On-Behalf-Of Payers (OBO) for accurate screening and rich data experience.**
- Ultimate Beneficiary Section is a new section introduced in the Payment Screen to add Ultimate Beneficiary (If applicable). Only Structured or Hybrid address is supported for Ultimate Beneficiary.
- There are no changes to the existing Address Section in Local Language.
- A new Bulk Import utility to migrate address of On-Behalf-Of Payers (OBO) from unstructured to structured or hybrid is available on Straight2Bank web to facilitate transition. Refer to Chapter 9 of this document for more details on *Bulk Import-OBO* utility.

**Important Notes for Structured Identification Sections**

- For fields '*Organisation Identifier Code - Occurrence-1*' & '*Organisation Identifier Code - Occurrence-2*', applicable Codes as per ISO20022 guidelines are *BANK, BDID, BOID, CBID, CHID, CINC, COID, CUST, DUNS, EMPL, GS1G, SREN, SRET, TXID*. You can choose the appropriate value from the drop down.
- Field '*Org - Identification Number (Occurrence1)*' is conditional mandatory if valid value is given in field '*Org - Code (Occurrence1)*' or '*Org - Proprietary (Occurrence1)*'. Similarly, field '*Org - Identification Number (Occurrence2)*' is conditional mandatory if valid value is given in field '*Org - Code (Occurrence2)*' or '*Org - Proprietary (Occurrence2)*'.
- For '*Birth Date*', applicable format is DD-MM-YYYY or DD/MM/YYYY. If Birth date is provided, then '*City of Birth*' and '*Country of Birth*' fields are mandatory. '*Birth Date*', '*City of Birth*' and '*Country of Birth*' are inter-related and if any of these values are provided without the other fields, then the mandatory error will be thrown for the respective missing fields.
- For Fields '*Individual Identifier Code - Occurrence-1*' & '*Individual Identifier Code - Occurrence-2*', applicable Codes as per ISO20022 guidelines are: *ARNU, CCPT, CUST, DRLC, EMPL, NIDN, POID, SOSE, TELE, TXID*. You can choose the appropriate value from the drop down.

- Field '*Individual - Identification Number (Occurrence1)*' is conditional mandatory, if valid value is given in field '*Individual - Code(Occurrence1)*' or '*Individual - Proprietary(Occurrence1)*'. Similarly, field '*Individual - Identification Number (Occurrence2)*' is conditional mandatory, if valid value is given in field '*Individual - Code(Occurrence2)*' or '*Individual - Proprietary(Occurrence2)*'.
- SWIFT BIC* captures Business Identification Code of the organisation, and the value of this field should be captured in the format as below: [A-Z,0-9] {4,4} [A-Z] {2,2} [A-Z0-9] {2,2} ([A-Z0-9] {3,3}) {0,1}.
- LEI* captures Legal Entity Identification of the organization and value of this field should be captured in the format as below: [A-Z,0-9] {18,18} [0-9] {2,2} i.e. first 18 char: A-Z & 0-9 supported. For last 2 characters: 0-9 only supported.

# 4 Extended Fields



## Overview

With ISO20022, industry is moving towards enriched and structured data and many existing fields are extended in field length to provide richer information.

**Standard Chartered is updating few existing fields in Payment, Beneficiary and On-Behalf-Of Payer screens on Straight2Bank Web to support maximum field lengths as per CBPR+ Guidelines. Tooltips and placeholder text will guide you for expected field length.**



## Important Notes for Extended Fields

- In addition to increase in field length, ISO Character set will be supported for these fields. Refer to Chapter 5 of this user guide for details on additional character set which will be supported.
- There will not be changes to field length of existing local language fields: *Beneficiary name in local language 1, Beneficiary name in local language 2, Address in local language 1, Address in local language 2, Address in local language 3, Address in local language 4.*
- Beneficiary Name will be extended to 140 characters for international payment. For domestic payments, existing beneficiary name length as per individual market regulation will be applicable. Tool tip with applicable field lengths will be displayed for guidance on screen based on Beneficiary market selection.

# 5 ISO Character Set



## Overview

ISO 20022 standard allows longer references for non-Latin alphabets, with a character set ten times larger than MT messages and carrying a great deal more information.

**New structured fields on Straight2Bank Beneficiary and On-Behalf-Of Payer module will support the character specifications listed below.**



## Important Notes for Character Set

- There will not be any changes to the character set supported by existing local language fields: *Beneficiary name in local language 1, Beneficiary name in local language 2, Address in local language 1, Address in local language 2, Address in local language 3, Address in local language 4.*
- There will not be any change to supported character set of any other fields besides the new ISO fields added as per Chapter 3 of this user guide.



## Updated ISO Character Set

- Besides new structured address and identification fields (as mentioned in chapter 2 of this user guide), other fields where extended ISO charset will be supported are: Beneficiary Name, Beneficiary Address 1, Beneficiary Address 2, Beneficiary Bank Name, Intermediary Bank Name, Beneficiary Email, On-Behalf-Of Payer Name, On-Behalf-Of Payer Address Line 1, On-Behalf-Of Payer Address Line 2 and Notes to Beneficiary.

*Note: There will be screen guidance provided to help you with direction on characters supported for a field.*

# 6 Beneficiary Journey



## Overview

As part of ISO 20022 implementation, following changes are implemented in Beneficiary (Earlier Label: Payee) module on Straight2Bank as per CBPR+ guidelines:

- New structured fields are added with enhanced character set (Refer Chapter 2 of User Guide for more details).
- Few existing fields are enhanced to support the maximum field length and enhanced character set (Refer Chapter 3 & 4 of User Guide for more details).
- Beneficiary Module is upgraded to more sophisticated UX framework resulting in less screen loading time and enhanced built-in error checking in the forms for seamless experience.

**As per ISO 20022 guidelines, unstructured address for Beneficiary will not be allowed from November 2026 by SWIFT. Standard Chartered is making structured/hybrid address mandatory (Town and Count minimally to be provided) from May 2026 and expect you to start using structured or hybrid address for your Beneficiaries as well update address of your pre-defined Beneficiaries to structured or hybrid for enriched experience and accurate screening. Please refer to Standard Chartered's address guideline for more details.**

# 9 Bulk Import

As part of ISO 20022 implementation, following changes are implemented in Bulk Import files on Staright2Bank to support CBPR+ guidelines:

- Changes are done to ipayment.csv specification to include new ISO fields and updates to existing fields to support maximum field length and enhanced character set as per CBPR+ guidelines.
- Changes are done to Bulk Import-Beneficiary specification to include new ISO fields and updates to existing fields which are enhanced to support the maximum field length and enhanced character set as per CBPR+ guidelines.
- An additional bulk import utility 'Bulk Import-OBO' is added to upload On-Behalf-Of Payers has been launched since August 2025 to allow you to upload structured or hybrid address of your pre-defined OBOs.

<b>On-Behalf-Of Payer (ISO Term: Ultimate Debtor)</b>	Party that owes an amount of money to the (ultimate) creditor. For this payment type, please mention party on whose behalf you are debiting the money.
<b>Beneficiary (ISO Term: Creditor)</b>	Party to which an amount to be credited. For this payment type, please mention Party to whom you want to send money to.
<b>Beneficiary Bank (ISO Term: Creditor Agent)</b>	Financial institution servicing an account for the creditor. For this payment type, please select bank of your beneficiary.
<b>Ultimate Beneficiary (ISO Term: Ultimate Creditor)</b>	Final Party which receives the payment amount in the end. For this payment type, please mention final creditor to whom money is credited to.
<b>End to End ID</b>	An end-to-end reference provided by the Initiating Party which must be passed unchanged throughout the payment and reported to the Creditor. Mention "Customer Reference" for tracking.
<b>Organisation ID</b>	Unique identifier to identify a party (Beneficiary, OBO, Ultimate Beneficiary) within a payment transaction.
<b>BIC</b>	BIC (Bank Identifier Code) identifies the financial institution involved in the payment.
<b>LEI</b>	Unique identification to identify party (Beneficiary, OBO, Ultimate Beneficiary) regardless of their location or type.
<b>Other (Organisation ID)</b>	Unique identification of an organization, as assigned by an institution, using an identification scheme. E.g. Tax Identification Number etc.
<b>Private ID</b>	Unique and unambiguous identification of a person.
<b>Birth Date</b>	Date on which a person is born.
<b>Province Of Birth</b>	Province where a person was born.
<b>City Of Birth</b>	City where a person was born.
<b>Country</b>	Country where a person was born.

# 11 FAQ

Some of the commonly asked questions are covered below.

**1. I submit my payment transactions through Bulk Import file. Are there any changes for me?**

Yes, changes are made to ipayment.csv to include new fields and existing fields are enhanced to support the max length and enhanced character set as per CBPR+ guidelines. Refer Section 9.1 for Updated Specification. Bank encourages you to use updated specifications to avoid any inconvenience.

**2. I use payment template to initiate payments on Straight2Bank Web. Are there any changes for me?**

Yes, payment templates are enhanced to include new ISO fields and extended field length wherever applicable.

Only structured/hybrid address will be allowed from May 2026 for Beneficiary on Straight2Bank Web, so please ensure address of pre-defined beneficiary mentioned in your payment template is structured or hybrid address.

If you have OBO transactions, please ensure address of pre-defined On-Behalf-Of Payer mentioned in your payment template is structured or hybrid address.

**3. Are there any changes to the existing process of managing or approving Beneficiary or OBO?**

There are no changes to how you view, review or access past Beneficiary and On-Behalf-Of Payer (OBO), manage and approve Beneficiary and On-Behalf-Of Payer (OBO).

**4. Is there any change to the existing Bulk Import File for Beneficiary?**

Yes, changes are made to Bulk Import-Beneficiary file to include new fields, and existing fields are enhanced to support the max length and enhanced character set as per CBPR+ guidelines. Refer Section 9.2 for Updated Specification. Bank encourages you to use updated specifications to avoid any inconvenience.

**5. I have too many predefined OBOs to move their address from unstructured to structured manually. Is there any utility to enable mass address change?**

Yes, an additional bulk import utility 'Bulk Import-On-Behalf-Of' to upload OBOs has been launched since Q3 2025 to allow you to upload structured or Hybrid address of your pre-defined On-Behalf-Of Payers (OBO). Refer Section 9.3 for File Specification.

**6. Will there be any field length change or additional character set support for local language fields as well?**

No. There is no change to existing local language fields in terms of field length or additional character support.

**7. Are ISO changes applicable across all payment types on web (BT, ACH, FAST, RTGS, TT, Statutory payment)?**

While ISO changes will be applicable for international payment across all markets, for payment on domestic rail, ISO changes will be applicable as per specific market local clearing system readiness and guidelines. There will be enough support available via walk me and banners to guide you on Straight2Bank Web.

#### **8. Are there changes expected for unstructured remittance information?**

The Bank will support the max 140 chars of unstructured remittance information for payment via Web with ISO character set per CBPR+ guideline.

#### **9. What is LEI and Standard Chartered recommendation for usage?**

Legal Entity Identifier (LEI) is a 20-character, alpha-numeric code based on the ISO 17442 standard. LEI connects to key reference information that enables clear and unique identification of legal entities participating in financial transactions. Each LEI contains information about an entity's ownership structure and thus answers the questions of 'who is who' and 'who owns whom'. The LEI (Legal Entity Identifier) may be used to identify financial institutions or debtor / creditor parties.

Standard Chartered Recommendation on usage of LEI is as per country regulation:

- Party: We highly recommend customers to provide following information in the sequence of preference when entering Beneficiary/Ultimate Beneficiary details: Name & Address (First preference), LEI, Other Id/BIC.
- Agent (Bank): We highly recommend customers to provide following information in the sequence of preference when entering agent (bank) details: BIC (First Preference), Clearing System Member Id, Name & Address else LEI

#### **10. Are there any market specific requirements for use of optional fields in payment- i.e. LEI, Purpose Codes, structured address for beneficiary, etc.?**

Based on Market/Clearing requirement, fields are available on UI Screen and have been marked as mandatory without which payment cannot be submitted. For Bulk Import-Payment, file specification will be shared, and fields marked as mandatory is must have for successful payment submission. In case, mandatory fields are not provided in bulk file transactions, then file will move in repair queue as BAU. Bank highly recommends you provide as much information as possible for accurate tracking, effective sanction screening and enriched information for faster reconciliation.

#### **11. Is it mandatory to provide structured address for Ultimate Beneficiary?**

Yes, SWIFT will support only structured or hybrid address for Ultimate Beneficiary. Please refer to address guideline for more details on difference between various address type like Unstructured, Structured and Hybrid Address.

#### **12. If I am a web customer who don't do OBO payments, am I still being impacted with this change?**

Yes. Unstructured address for Beneficiary will not be allowed by SWIFT from November 2026 and bank will not support unstructured address from May 2026 on Straight2Bank web. Bank strongly encourage you to use structured address for both parties and agents (banks) including all sub-elements of postal address, wherever possible.

#### **13. We make OBO payments. If we miss to change our existing OBO information as per CBPR+ guidelines by November 2025, what will happen to the payments that we initiate after that?**

As per SWIFT guidelines, only structured or hybrid address for OBO is acceptable starting November 2025. Start providing structured or hybrid address for your one-time and pre-defined On-Behalf-Of Payer (OBO) as per industry timeline to take advantage of accurate screening and rich data.

#### **14. We use templates that we have created using custom file formats to bulk import files today on Straight2Bank. Will our file upload continue to work using those templates?**

If you have used parties like Beneficiary, OBO and Ultimate Beneficiary in the payment template which has unstructured address, then at the time of payment submission, system will prompt you to enter structured address for selected parties as mandatory check.

**15. We use payment templates to make recurring or frequent payments & party details (beneficiary, OBO and Ultimate Beneficiary) are maintained as part of that. Do we need to make changes to those templates as well?**

Yes, please ensure that parties used in your payment template has structured or hybrid address, before initiating payment.

**16. We use advance analytics dashboard for Cash. Will the drill downs on my transactions there have fields that are added in new for our visibility?**

Yes, analytics dashboard will show transactions with new ISO fields as applicable.

**17. We authorise payments that we upload via H2H/File upload on Straight2Bank Web. Do we need to make changes to our payment files?**

Yes, ISO changes and validations will be applicable on transactions initiated via H2H/File upload but authorized via Straight2Bank Web.

**18. I have too many pre-defined beneficiaries, will bank help me to update unstructured address to structured/hybrid?**

Yes, we will start showing statistics of your existing beneficiary template with unstructured address from June 2026 under Pending Task dashboard on Straight2Bank Web as reminder to update your templates.

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
