

Using DocuSign for Electronic Signature on contracts with the Bank

Standard Chartered Bank adopts electronic signatures using DocuSign, in jurisdictions permitted by respective legislation and regulators.



Manual overhead with printing and scanning are saved Signing and viewing can be performed anywhere any time



You are out of office? You can use 'Delegate' feature if your company is a paid DocuSign client. Go to 'My Preferences' to set delegation to another colleague for the period involved.



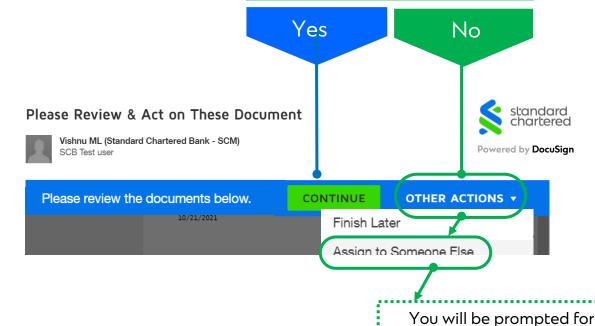
You will first receive an SCB email sent by DocuSign



Key question to consider:

Are you authorised to sign?

name & email address and a message for the assignee

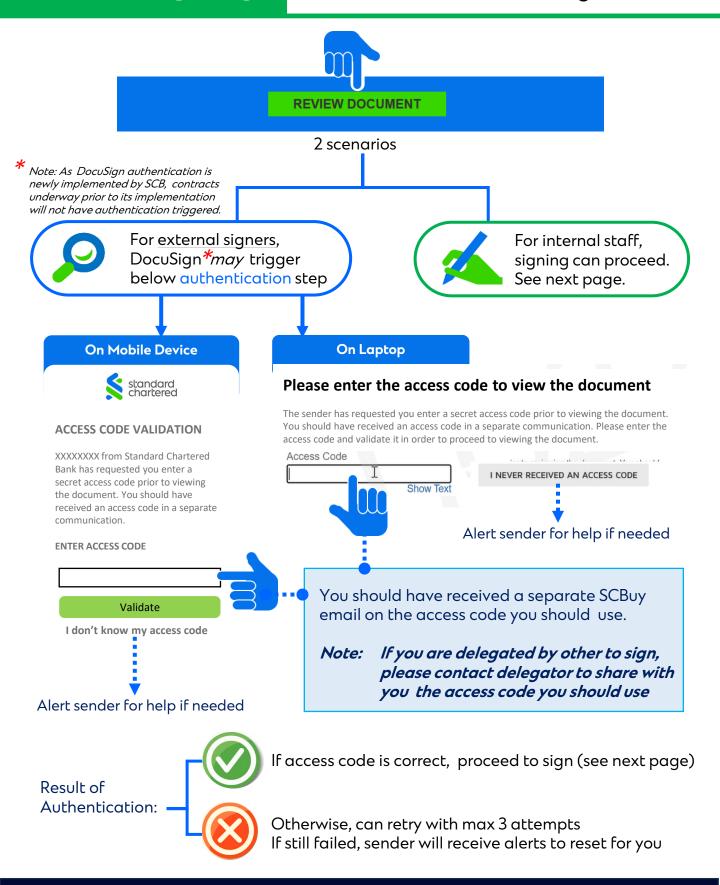


<u>IMPORTANT</u>

Original signer is fully responsible to ensure that the person reassigned to is an appropriately authorized person within the organization.

Before Signing

Click 'Review Document' button in email to launch DocuSign

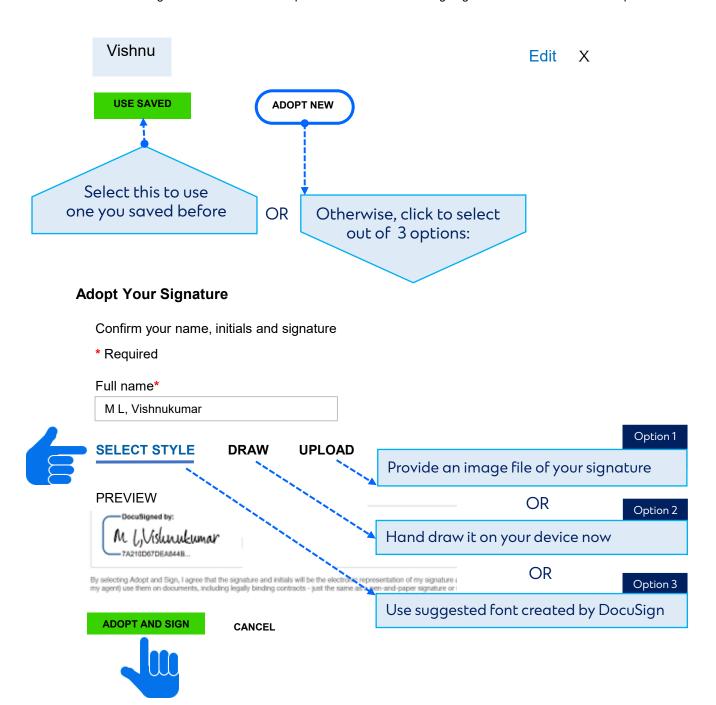


When Signing

Signers can download signed contract & audit trail in DocuSign

Signers will be notified after contract was fully signed

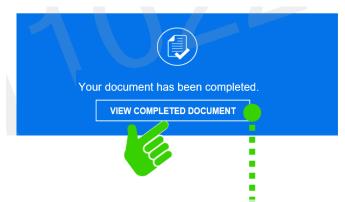
