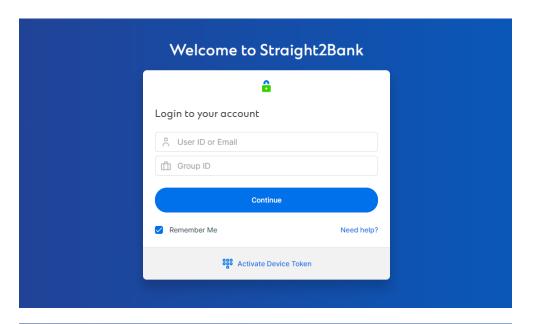


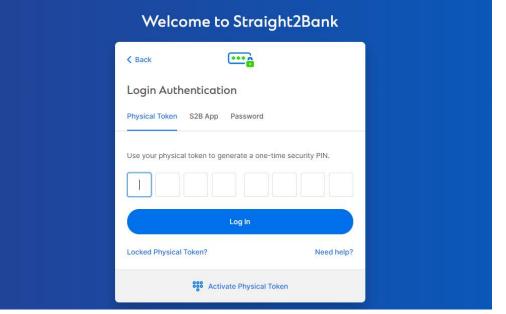

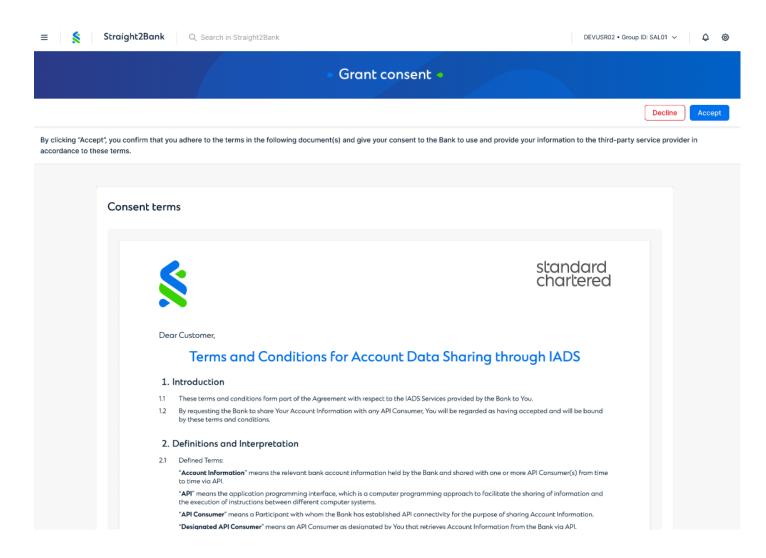
1. After you are re-directed from the data consuming bank to S2B, login with your Group ID, User ID and physical/mobile token as you usually log into S2B.





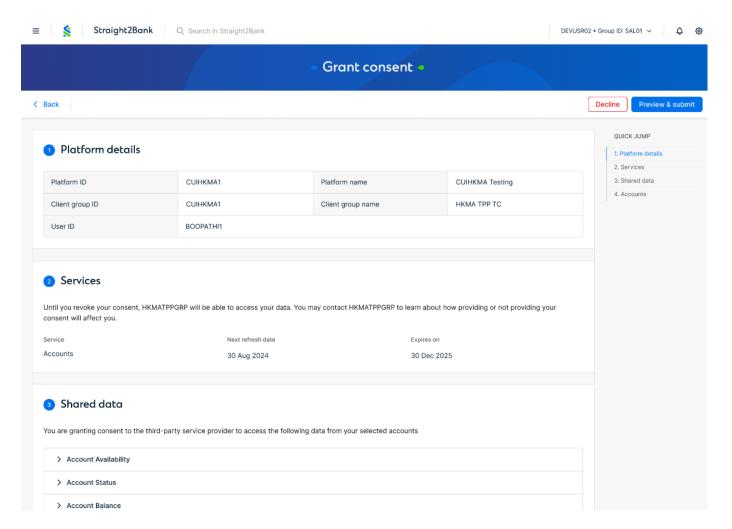


2. Carefully read and review the Terms displayed. Click Accept.



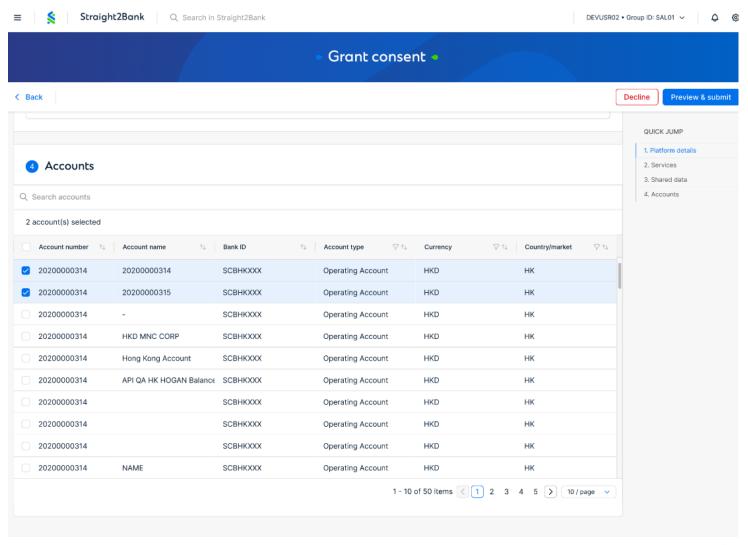


3. Review the consent details displayed.



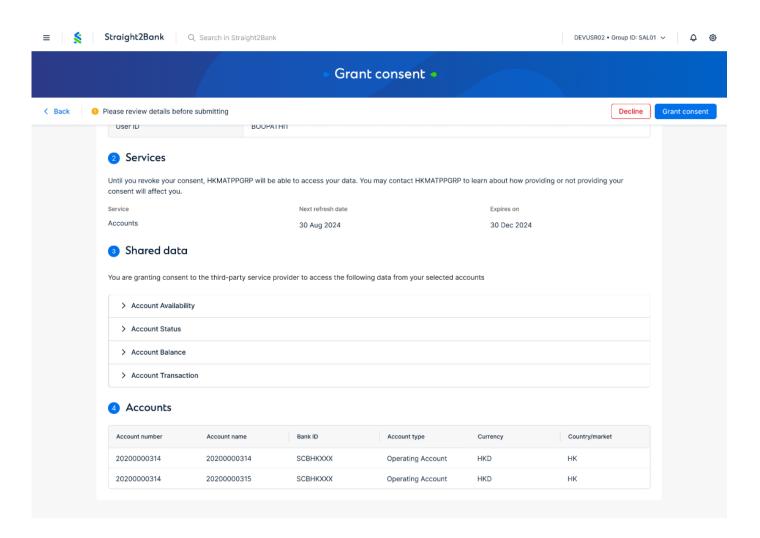


4. Select the accounts for which data will be shared with the data consuming bank.
Click Preview & submit.





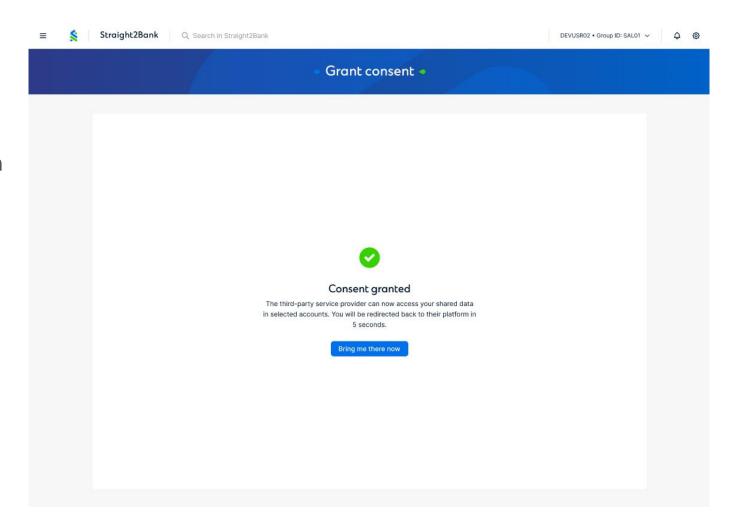
5. Review the details of the consent. To proceed, click Grant consent.





6. Upon clicking Grant consent, the consent is granted. You will be redirected to the data consuming bank's portal.

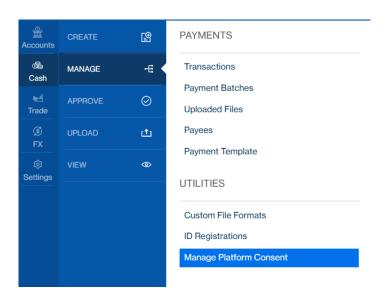
You will receive an email notification on the completion of granting a consent.



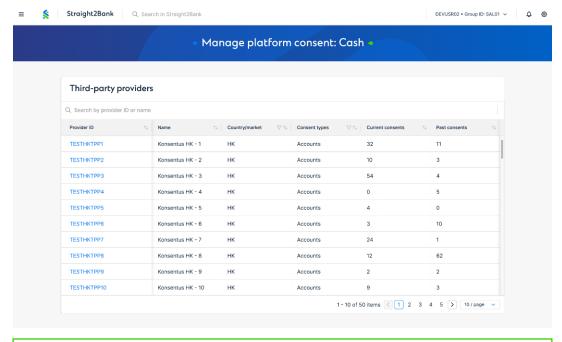


### View Consent(s) on S2B

2. Your consents are categorized by third-party service providers\* including data consuming banks. You may see the number of consents granted to each data consuming bank.

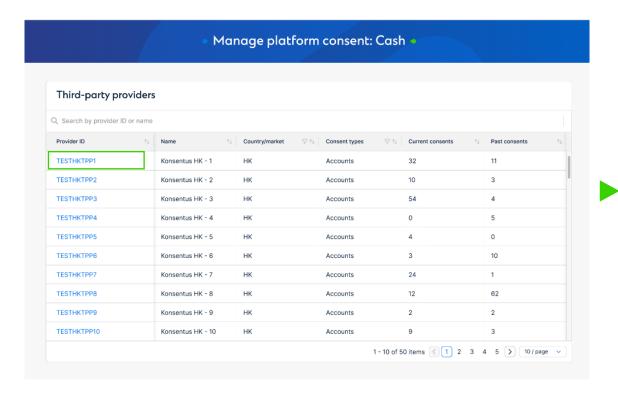


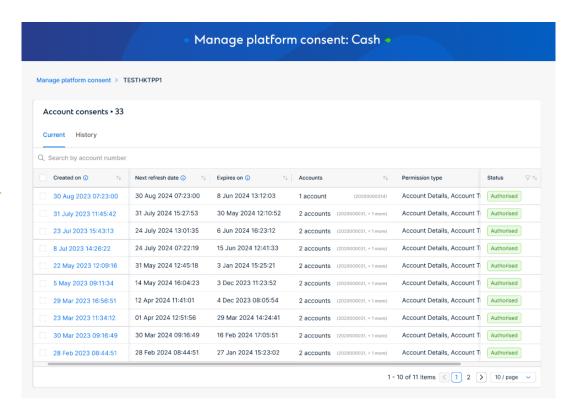

3. To view all consents granted to a data consuming bank, click on the Provider ID.

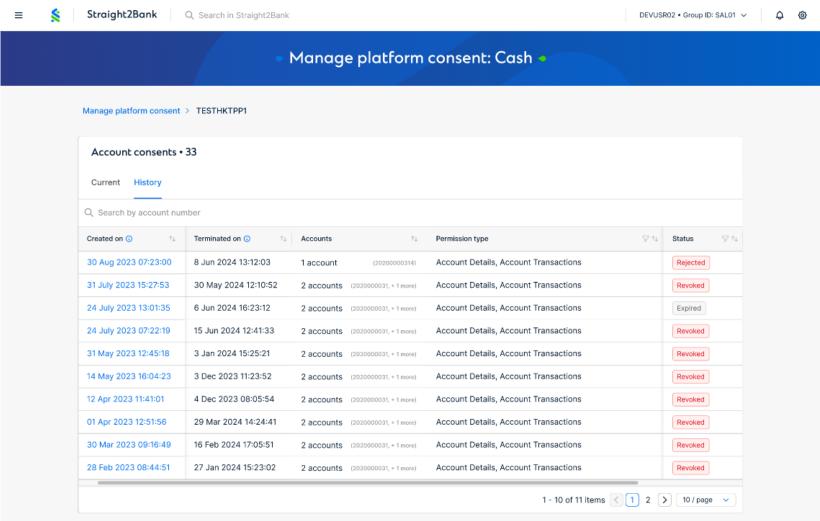

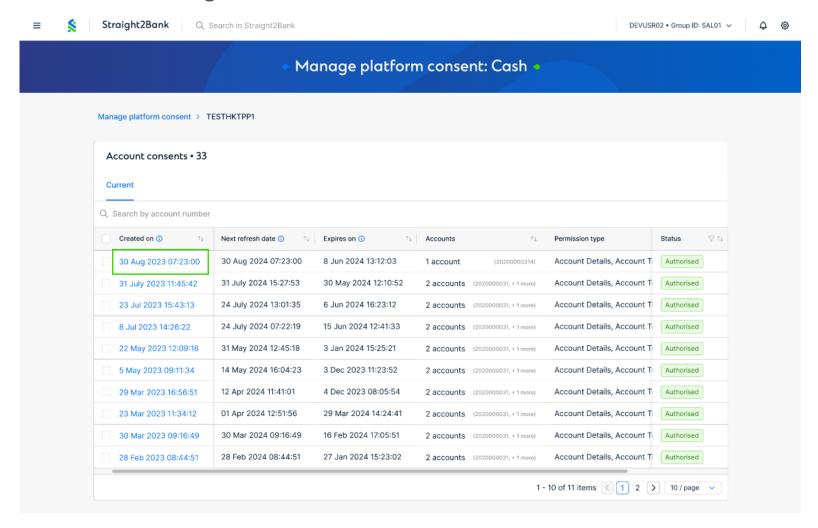
4. To view revoked/expired consents click on History.





## Revoke Consent (Single consent)

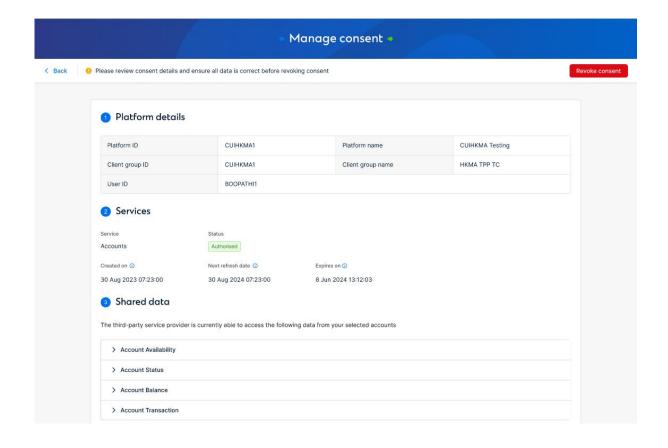
1. To revoke a single consent, click on the consent creation date of that consent.



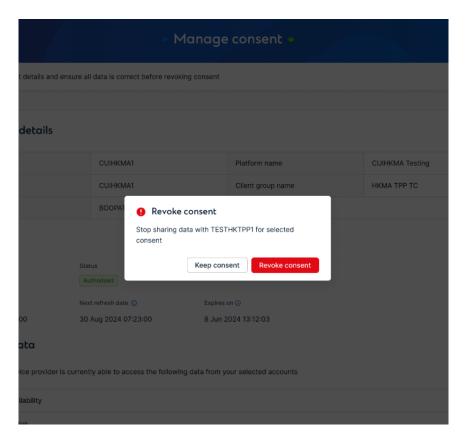

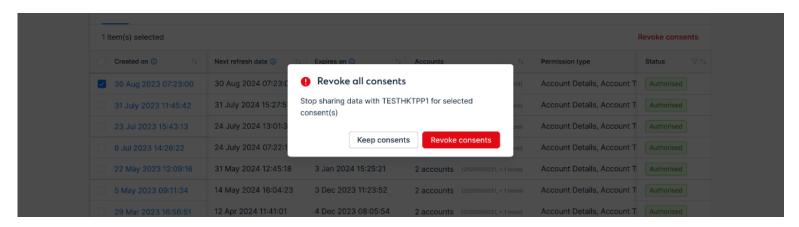
1. Select the consents to be revoked, click Revoke consents.



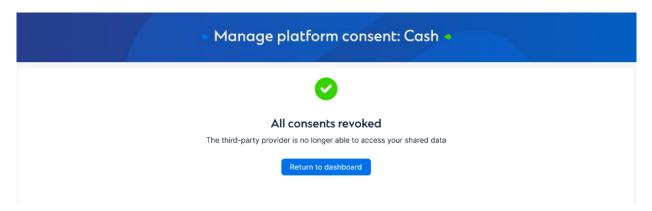
