Standard Chartered Bank supports Environmental Conservation, plants 100 trees at Berakas Forest Reserve.

Bandar Seri Begawan, 14 February 2017 – In efforts to raise awareness on conservation of the environment within the community, Standard Chartered Bank planted 100 trees and collected more than 20 bags of rubbish at the Berakas Forest Reserve today.

More than 20 Standard Chartered staff and members of Green Brunei made their way to the Berakas Forest Reserve to take part in this initiative. In addition, 20 individuals from the Forestry Department also came together to lend their helping hand with the tree planting initiative.

As part of the Green Brunei Conservation Initiative, which the Bank supports, two types of trees (Caruarina Equisetifolia and Hibiscus Tiliaceus) were planted along the Berakas beach to prevent soil erosion while adding to the forest reserve.

The event began with welcome remarks and a briefing delivered by Yang Berhormat Dayang Khairunnisa binti Awang Haji Ash'ari and before the tree planting activity commenced; volunteers were given a planting demonstration conducted by the Forestry Department to ensure that the trees were planted correctly.
