John Barnes in town for SC Trophy GhanaRoad to Anfield 2016



11 March 2016, Accra – **Standard Chartered Bank** today welcomed Liverpool Football Club Legend John Barnes to this year's Standard Chartered Ghana Trophy 2016 tournament.

A skilful left wing player, John Barnes played for Liverpool from 1987 to 1997 during which Barnes won the then top-flight First Division twice and the FA Cup twice. He also played for the England national team on 79 occasions. During his playing career Barnes was named the PFA Players' Player of the Year twice (in 1987–88 and 1989–90) and the Football Writers' Association Footballer of the Year once (in 1987–88). In 2005 he was inducted into the English Football Hall of Fame.
