## Standard Chartered Alert on Fraudulent Email, Website

Standard Chartered Bank (Hong Kong) Limited (the "Bank") would like to alert its customers of two scam emails sent by

standardC@info.hk and hongkong@hsbc.hk

The emails request the recipient to click on "Register for HSBC new Security Service", which then connects to the fake websites www.eurofoodstuff.com.hk/images/files/SC/HomePage.html and

www.eurofoodstuff.com.hk/images/files/Stand/HSBC1.htm respectively, to solicit the recipient's personal information.

Customers are strongly advised not to access such website. They should ensure they are connected to a valid Standard Chartered's website before keying in any confidential personal data.

Standard Chartered would like to remind its customers that it does not request customers' personal information (including user names and passwords) by email. Passwords, such as One-Time passwords, are also never requested by the Bank over the phone. Customers are further reminded that they should only log into Standard Chartered Online Banking through the Bank's website <u>www.sc.com/hk/</u> and not through hyperlinks embedded in emails or third party websites.

The Bank has reported the above-said incident to the Hong Kong Police and has urged the administrators of this website in question to remove it immediately.
