Liverpool FC to play in Indonesia for first time

Liverpool FC have today confirmed that the Club will make history this year when they play their first ever match in Indonesia.

The Reds, winners of five European Cups and 18 league titles, will play a match on July 20th as part of the 2013 pre-season tour presented by main sponsor Standard Chartered.
