

Q. Do I have to pay any fee to participate in the Rewards Programme?

A. No. There is no fee. You will be automatically enrolled in the Rewards Programme as a Standard Chartered Credit Cardholder.

Q. How are my Reward Points calculated? How can I earn more Reward Points?

A. As a Gold Credit Cardholder you earn 1 Reward Point for every KES 100 spent on your Standard Chartered Credit Card and as a Platinum Credit Cardholder you will earn 1.5 Reward Points for every KES 100 spent on the Standard Chartered Platinum Credit Card. For example, if you spend KES 10,000 on your Gold Credit Card, you will earn 100 Reward Points and 150 Reward Points if you have a Platinum Credit Card. You can accumulate more Reward Points faster by using your Standard Chartered Credit Card for every transaction, small or big, from shopping to utility bill payments.

Q. Which Credit Card transactions are eligible to earn Reward Points?

A. You will earn Reward Points for all retail purchases, as well as for utility bill payments and online payments. You can earn Reward Points for using your Standard Chartered Credit Card in Kenya and in any other country. However, you will not earn Reward Points towards cash advances, cash withdrawals and fees such as Joining fee, annual fee, interest charges, Supplementary card fee, late payment fee, overlimit fee, credit life insurance premiums, and other charges levied by the Bank. In addition, transactions that earn cash back will not earn Reward Points.

Q. How can I keep a track of Reward Points I have accumulated?

A. Your monthly Credit Card statement will show your Reward Points earned, redeemed and expired. The Reward Points will reflect in your monthly statement once the transaction appears in the statement. You may also call the Standard Chartered Customer Contact Centre on 020 3293900 to learn how many Reward Points you have accumulated.

Q. Can Supplementary Cardholders also accumulate Reward Points and order a gift?

A. Yes. All retail purchase transactions made by your Supplementary Credit Card can earn Reward Points. However, these Reward Points will be added to your Primary Credit Card account and redemption can only be done by a Primary Cardholder.

Q. When and how can I redeem my Reward Points?

A. You can start redeeming your Reward Points as soon as you have accumulated 5000 Reward Points and have sufficient points to redeem against any of the gifts/ services in this catalogue. You have to fill in the redemption form attached at the end of this Rewards Catalogue with the details of the gifts you want to order and fax it to us. In this Rewards Catalogue you can find the gifts with the number of Reward Points indicated against each item and their code.

Q. How will I receive my gifts?

We will process your redemption application form and mail a redemption letter/voucher to your mailing address entitling you to collect your gift from the specified outlet.

- Q. How long will it take to receive my gifts? Can I change or cancel orders once placed? Please allow us one working week to process your order and to mail the redemption letter/ voucher. No changes or cancellations will be allowed once the orders are placed.
- Q. Do my Reward Points have an expiry date? Yes. Your Reward Points are valid for 3 years from the moment you earn them. You need to redeem them within the first three years of earning to avoid expiry of your Reward Points.

Q. When are my Reward Points not redeemable?

A. You will not be able to accumulate or redeem Reward Points if the relevant date the Credit Card has been withdrawn or cancelled, or is liable to be cancelled, or if your Standard Chartered Credit Card account is a delinquent account, or if there is any breach of any clause of the Terms and Conditions of the Cardholder Agreement, or if you have not paid the minimum amount due on your Credit Card within the due date.
