## **Deputy Head of FCC of Standard Chartered, David Howes, in Nepal**

**David Howes**, the Deputy Head of Financial Crime Compliance (FCC) at Standard Chartered Group is currently in Nepal. Mr Howes is responsible for the FCC teams supporting Standard Chartered's Regions and Businesses. He has been closely involved in setting the strategy for the Bank's enhancements to its FCC control environment.
