Standard Chartered's Priority Banking in Japan to cease its operation at Marunouchi Branch

28 May 2013, Tokyo – Standard Chartered Bank announced that its Priority Banking service at current Marunouchi Branch will end on 31 May 2013, and the remaining services will be merged into Tokyo Branch starting from 1 June 2013.

In line with the Priority Banking business closure in Japan, as previously announced on 26 November 2012, the Bank decided to cease its Priority Banking operation at Marunouchi Branch (1/F Kishimoto Bldg., 2-2-1 Marunouchi, Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo) on 31 May 2013. The Tokyo Branch (21/F Sanno Park Tower, 2-11-1 Nagata-cho, Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo) remains open with limited scope of the services.
