Standard Chartered Bank employees donate PHP1.5 million to Mindanao earthquake victims



Standard Chartered Bank officers led in the distribution of relief and recovery kits to earthquake victims in Sarangani province.



Standard Chartered Bank officers, together with the PBSP, Municipality of Maasin Vice Mayor Visitacion Nambatac, and OND HESED Foundation, brought early recovery kits to more than 280 priority households in isolated communities in General Santos City and Sarangani Province to help them rebuild and regain access to essential food, hygiene, shelter and daily-use items following the earthquake.

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Standard Chartered Bank (SCB) employees, in partnership with the Philippine Business for Social Progress (PBSP), donated PHP1.5 million to provide relief and recovery assistance to hundreds of indigenous Lumad families in the upland barangays of Maasim, Sarangani Province, particularly members of the T'boli and Blaan communities affected by the devastating 7.8-magnitude earthquake in June.
