Standard Chartered Bank donates PPE sets for medical frontliners in Pasig City

Mayor Vico Sotto recently received 1,000 reusable personal protective equipment (PPE) sets and more than 270 pieces of nitrile gloves for Pasig City's frontline health workers from Standard Chartered Bank (SCB) as the oldest international bank in the Philippines continues to distribute much needed health care supplies around the country.

The PPE sets will be distributed to Pasig General Hospital, Rizal Medical Center, Tricity Medical Center and Pasig City Health Department for the city's quarantine facilities. The PPE sets include washable coveralls, foot covers and face shields to help protect medical staff from the risk of COVID-19 infection.

The donation was made in partnership with the Philippine Business for Social Progress through its platform Bayanihan Musikahan for COVID relief aid. The bank's relief efforts include distribution of food packs to 10,000 households in NCR and Region 4A and more than 11,000 PPE kits to hospitals and treatment centers in Luzon and Cebu City.
