



Standard Chartered Bank donates PPE sets to Quezon City

Quezon City Mayor Joy Belmonte received 1300 reusable personal protective equipment (PPE) sets from Standard Chartered Bank (SCB), the oldest international bank in the Philippines. These PPE sets will be distributed to Delos Santos Medical Center, Quirino Medical Center, World Citi Medical Center and United Doctors Medical Center and United Doctors Medical Center.
