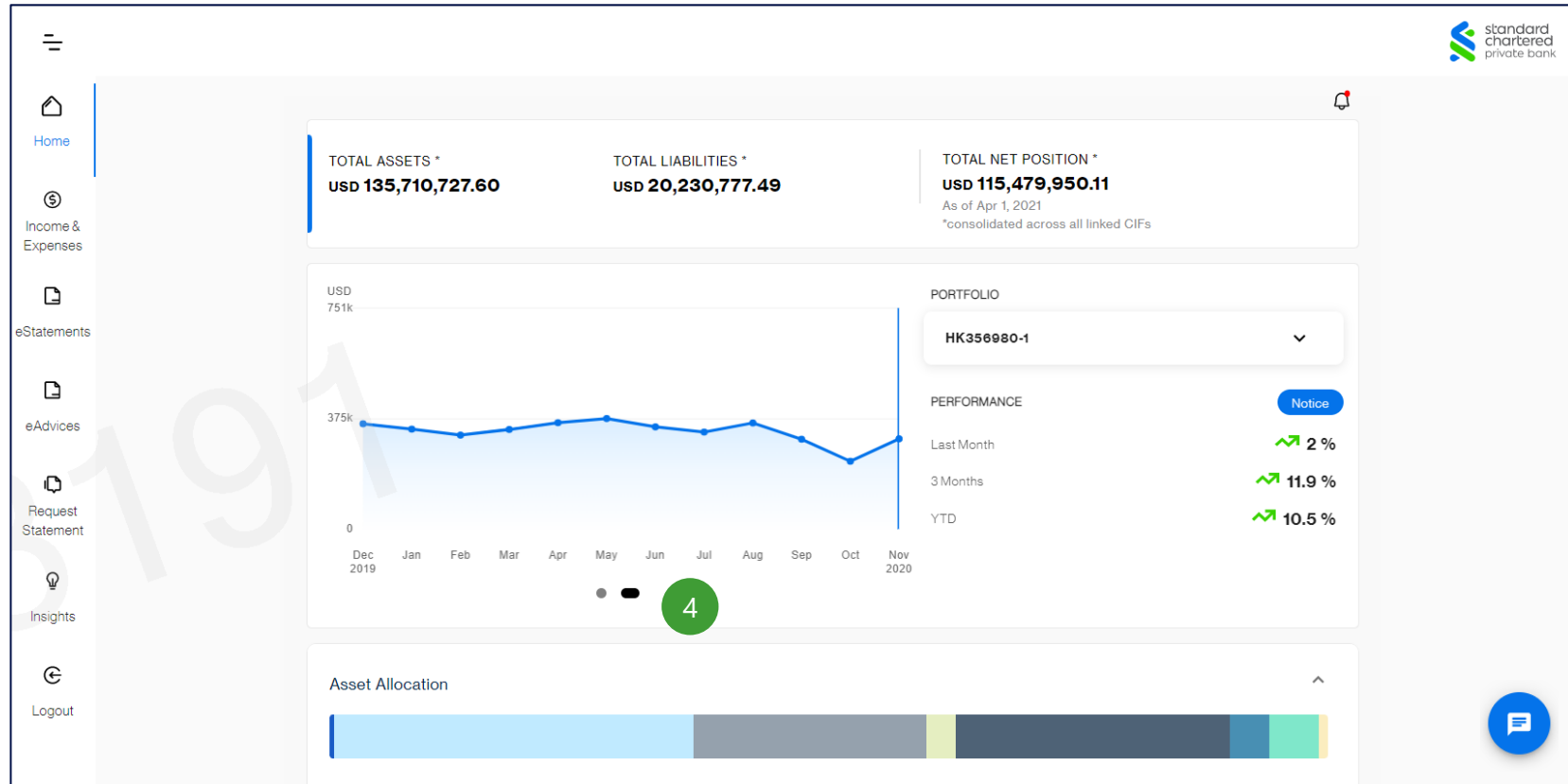

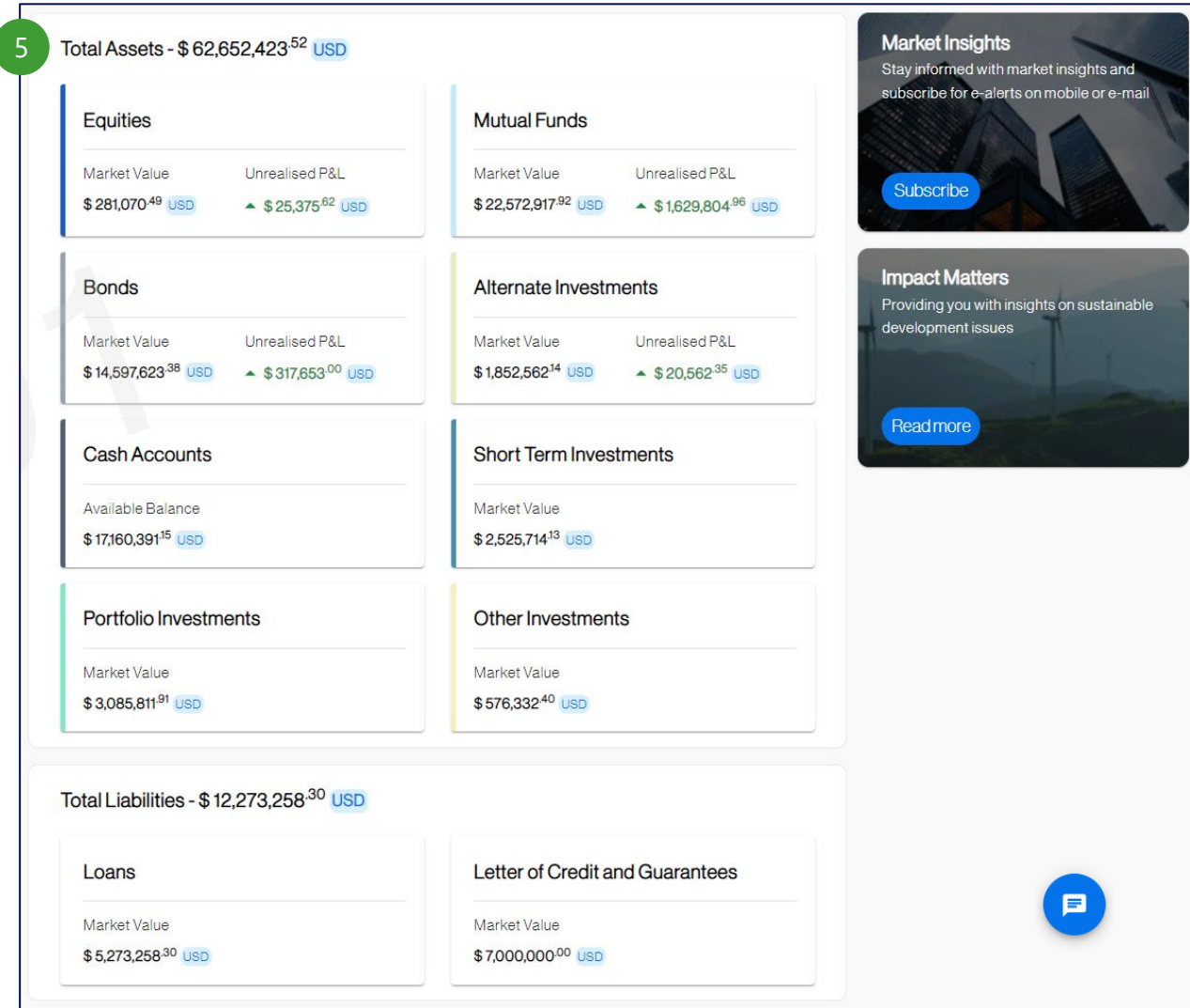

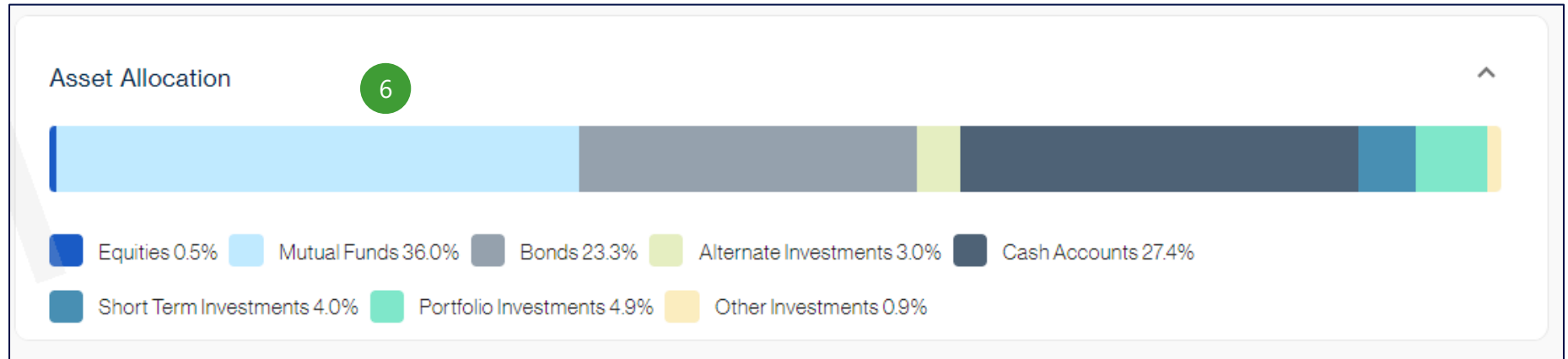

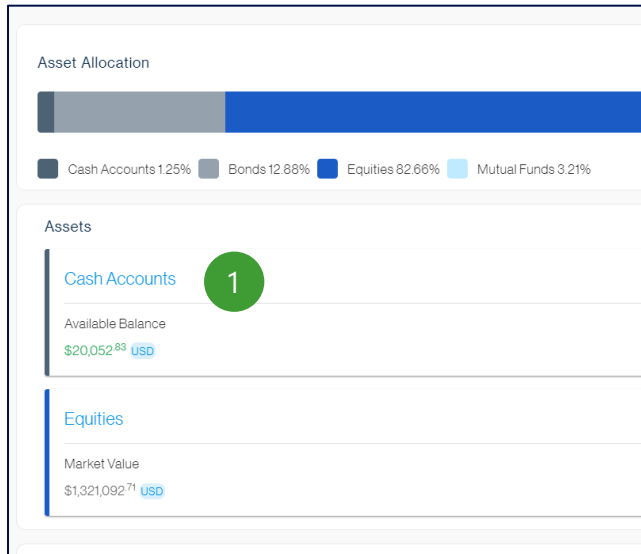

**US equities fall amid inflation concerns**

**SUMMARY**

- US equities fell sharply on Friday, with the S&P500 down 2.1%. This followed the release of US January jobs data which showed a pick up wage growth which pushed US Treasury yields higher.
- We remain positive on equities. While weakness could extend in the very short term, strong earnings and economic growth mean we would use the pullback to add to our preferred equity markets where investors have been looking for an opportunity to do so.
- Key technical levels: 2685 is a key support for the S&P500 while 2.85% is a key resistance for 10-year US Treasury yields.

**BACKGROUND**

- US equities fell last week. The S&P 500 fell 2.1% on Friday resulting in a 3.1% fall over the full week. However, year-to-date (YTD) S&P500 returns are still positive at 3.3% and the fall comes in the context of a global equities rally that has gone without a pullback in over a year. The trend has been similar in other key equity markets, with Euro area and Asia ex-Japan equities still up 4.1% and 5.6% YTD (in USD) despite falling last week.
- Move follows earlier rise in US Treasury yields. Yields rose on the back of the market's rising expectations of future inflation and technical breaks higher, triggering concerns they may start to act as a drag on equity markets should the rise continue. See the Weekly Market View (2-Feb-2018) for more details.
- US employment data showed acceleration of wage growth. US non-farm payrolls data for January released on Friday showed a further, albeit modest, acceleration in wage growth to 2.9% y/y, the fastest pace since 2009. This continues to be a focus for financial markets as one potential indicator of higher inflation in the future.
